



Twinbrook Swimming Pool Rules - 2016

Pool management will have the authority and discretion to maintain a safe and enjoyable environment.

POOL ACCESS – Members must verify membership at the entry gate sign in log.

1. All guests must be accompanied by a pool member who is responsible for their behavior.
2. No one with infectious diseases may enter the pool premises.
3. Children under the age of ten (10) who are on the pool premises must be supervised by a by a responsible person over the age of fifteen (15) or a parent. All children must be supervised by an adult.
4. Neither the Corporation nor its employees are responsible for lost or stolen articles.
5. No glass containers are permitted.
6. Lifeguards may at any time declare any act unsafe and prohibited.
7. A lifeguard may request that any person violating any of the published rules or regulations take a time out at the place of the guards choosing and may impose additional consequences.
8. A pool manager has the discretion to close the pool only with the consent of a Board Member.
9. The pool may be closed due to inclement weather. In case of lightning, the pool will be cleared immediately and will remain cleared for at least forty-five (45) minutes after the last lightning event. The pool will remain cleared for 30 minutes after the last audible thunder.
10. The Twinbrook Swimming Pool Corporation or its employees cannot be held responsible for any damage or injury resulting from an individual failing to adhere to pool rules and regulations.

BEHAVIOR

1. Foul language, spitting, chewing gum, splashing others, running, pushing, dunking or rough play are prohibited anywhere on the property.
2. Street shoes and street clothes are prohibited on the deck areas adjacent to either pool.
3. Food and beverages are not allowed in deck area around the main pool and within three (3) feet of the baby pool. Patron must dispose of trash in the proper receptacles. Recycling is appreciated.
4. Alcoholic beverages are allowed on pool premises by persons over 21, and at parties which have been approved by the Board.
5. Smoking is permitted only in designated outside of the pool fence. The butts must be properly disposed of. Smoking is permitted only for individuals who meet the States age requirement of eighteen (18).
6. All injuries must be reported to the pool manager. All members will assist in maintaining a family atmosphere.
7. The use of skates, skateboards, bicycles and other wheeled devices are prohibited within the perimeter fence.
8. All water guns and water propellant devices are prohibited.
9. Weapons are prohibited from pool property. Possession of a weapon will result in immediate expulsion and revocation of membership with no refund.

THE POOLS

1. All pool users must shower before entering any pool.
2. No cut-offs are allowed in any pool.
3. Non-toilet trained children must wear specially designed pool diapers ("Swimmies") covered by plastic/rubber pants with elastic legs and waist in any pool. No rubber pants over regular diapers will be allowed. No pool diapers without plastic/rubber pants with elastic legs and waist will be allowed.
4. Feet must be rinsed before entering either pool.

MAIN POOL

1. All children who swim in the main pool must be accompanied by a responsible adult unless they have passed a swim test administered under the supervision of a lifeguard. Arm flotation devices may be used only with parental supervision in the water.
2. When diving boards are in use, enter the diving well only from a board; only one person at a time; only one bounce on the board; go straight off the board; only one person in the diving well at one time. Only tested people are allowed in the diving well.
3. During adult-only swim, fifteen (15) minutes before each hour, only persons eighteen (18) years and older are allowed inside the fence. Children are to rest during these times and are not allowed in the baby pool.
4. Rafts may only be used during raft parties.
5. The use of floating rings is prohibited.
6. Only small and soft toys marketed for pool use are allowed in the main pool, for example noodles and squishy balls. BABY POOL – Small Pool

1. Toys are permitted in the baby pool.
2. Children over six (6) years of age are not permitted in the baby pool.
3. Children in baby pool must be supervised by a responsible person over the age of eighteen (18) or a parent.

CONSEQUENCES

Consequences for offenses may include but not be limited to the following:

- Offender will sit out for 1 youth swim (45) minutes;
- Offender will have the choice of leaving the pool for the remainder of the day or perform 1 hour of pool service with parental notification;
- Offender will have a three (3) day suspension from the pool with parental notification;
- Offender will have a one week (7 days) suspension and a mandatory meeting with parents prior to re admittance;
- Offender will be expelled from the pool for the remainder of the season with no partial or complete refund.
